### **Museum Tour Guide/Docent**

Our knowledgeable volunteer docents conduct tours throughout the house and the complex. You will become well versed with the history of the Bellamy Mansion through our in-house docent training program.

### **Visitor Center Host or Hostess/Receptionist**

“Welcome to the Bellamy Mansion, may I tell you about our tours?” Be one of the first people to greet and welcome visitors as they enter the Carriage House Visitor Center – greeter, gift shop and reception desk assistance is always needed.

### **Gardening**

Both casual garden enthusiasts and master gardeners are welcome. Weather permitting, a twice monthly morning schedule on Wednesday mornings (once monthly in winter and mid-summer) helps keep our antebellum garden planted and well tended.

### **Office Assistance**
